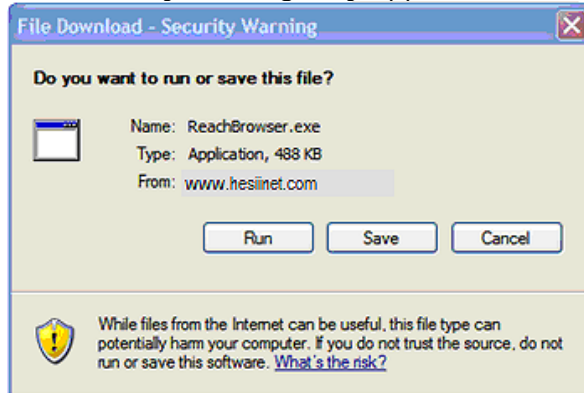


Evolve® Reach™ iNet Exam Student Instructions

1. To begin your exam, open Internet Explorer and enter the following:
<https://www.hesiinet.com>
Note: depending on your operating system, your screens may vary slightly.
2. To begin your test, click **"Start taking an Exam"** under the section labeled Students.
3. A security warning may appear: click **RUN** (Windows 2000 users, click "Open").



4. Another security warning may appear: click **RUN**



5. Please enter your Evolve account information and the access code provided by your proctor. If you do not have an Evolve account, please provide the necessary information: First and Last name, Access Code, Email address and Student ID.

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10. You are required to answer each question before clicking Next. You will not be allowed to return to a previous question. Select an answer by typing the letter (A, B, C, D) or by selecting the answer with your mouse. Refer to the grey box to the right of the answer choices for more information on the question type and how to answer. Click **Next** or use the Enter key to advance to the next question. You may temporarily exit your exam by clicking “Submit and Pause/Leave Exam.” You may return to your exam where you left off if allowed by your instructor. The “Remaining Time” display indicates the amount of time remaining for the exam. Although you may receive a warning that you have exceeded a time limit, you will not be prevented from finishing your exam.
